Region of Origin: Gualtallary, Tupungato, Mendoza, Argentina. Estate grown produced and bottled.

Winemaker: Joaquín Martín

Vineyard: By the Andes, altitude 4000 feet. Soils of alluvial origin, loose and highly permeable structure.

Vinification: Manual harvest and transport in plastic bins, destemmed and vatted in stainless steel tanks by gravity, the Sauvignon Blanc bunches are separated on a selection belt, prior to destemming and then added whole bunch in the fermentation tank. Cold maceration for three days and post-fermentation based on tasting, fermentation with indigenous yeasts.

Ageing: aged in French oak barrels for 12 months.

Composition: 94% Cabernet Franc 6% Sauvignon Blanc

Tasting notes: Wine with concentrated violet tones, bright. On the nose, the first impression are herbal notes, thyme predominates, to continue with spices such as red pepper and cloves, then the wood adds complexity with notes of dulce de leche and coffee. On the palate, the entrance is powerful and vertical with a marked acidity, round and juicy tannins that are maintained from the beginning to the end of the mouth.
